### 1. Prestigious Terroir in Rovereto di Gavi

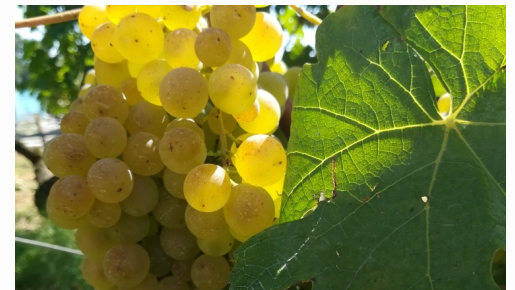
The vineyards are situated at 260 meters in one of Gavi's most esteemed areas, benefiting from south-facing slopes, clay-rich soils, full sun, and constant maritime breezes that create a unique Mediterranean microclimate in northern Italy.

### 2. Pure, High-Quality Cortese

Grapes are hand-harvested and vinified with minimal intervention, fermented exclusively in stainless steel, and carefully managed to preserve the varietal's natural acidity, freshness, and minerality.

### 3. A Veritable Legacy

Founded in 1945 by Lorenzo Picollo, the estate has been nurtured across three generations. It is now run by his grandson, Gianlorenzo Picollo.
