2. Multi-Vineyard Sourcing for Balance

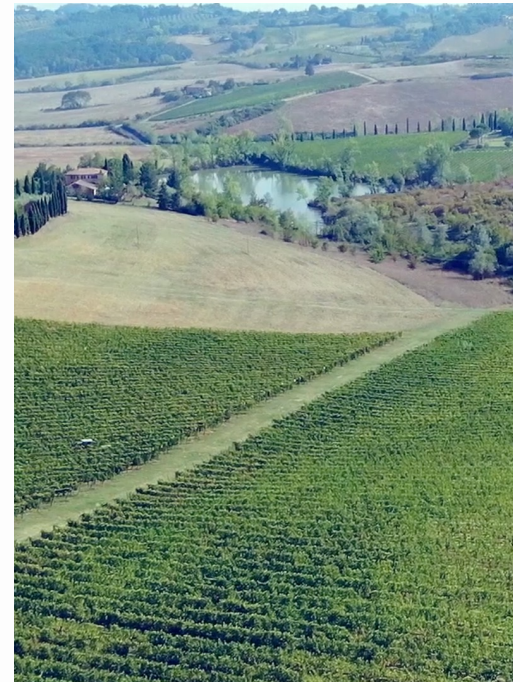
